

THE FOREST

More than one million hectares of trees, almost half of all Britain's woods, belong to the nation and the Forestry Commission manages them on your behalf.

Forest Holidays is part of the Forestry Commission and is unique in offering a network of sites in forests and woodlands managed by the Forestry Commission.

In the surrounding woodlands you'll find forest drives and visitor centres ... forest walks for people of all abilities ... picnic sites and play areas ... cycle routes ... orienteering courses ... rivers and streams ... dramatic mountains, deep valleys and peaceful forest glades.

Glenmore is located in the heart of Glenmore Forest Park, at the foot of the Cairngorms, surrounded by forests and ancient woods of native pine and birch.

Glenmore Forest Park is a haven for red and roe deer, red squirrels, wildcat, capercaillie. You may glimpse an osprey hunting over the waters of the loch.

Crested tits nosily forage through the foliage or crossbills with their cone opener beaks ... the nocturnal pine marten, the emblem of the Forest Park, slip quietly through the trees.

Glenmore Forest Park Visitor Centre

The Forestry Commission Visitor Centre is across the road from the site. It has an audio visual presentation about the Forest Park, natural and cultural history displays as well as a cafe and shop selling publications and guide maps as well as forest souvenirs.
