Boarding Restrictions

Between Stirling and Fort William and Skye, services 913, 914, 915 and 916 will pick up passengers at the stops listed overleaf and safe unmarked stopping places.

Post Bus Connections

Post bus connections are available at Lix Toll to/from Killin as shown overleaf. The fare between Lix Toll and Killin is 85p single and payable to the Post Bus driver at the time of travel.

Reserving your seat

All Citylink services shown on this timetable are reservable. Customers are automatically given a reservation for their outward journey. The return portion can be reserved free of charge if booked at the same time. If you wish to book a seat for your return journey after this time a charge is applicable. You must

book the return portion of your journey at least 24 hours in advance. You must board the coach a **minimum of 10 minutes prior to departure** on both the outward and return portions. Customers who fail to do so risk losing the opportunity to travel on the booked service and may have to travel on the next available service.

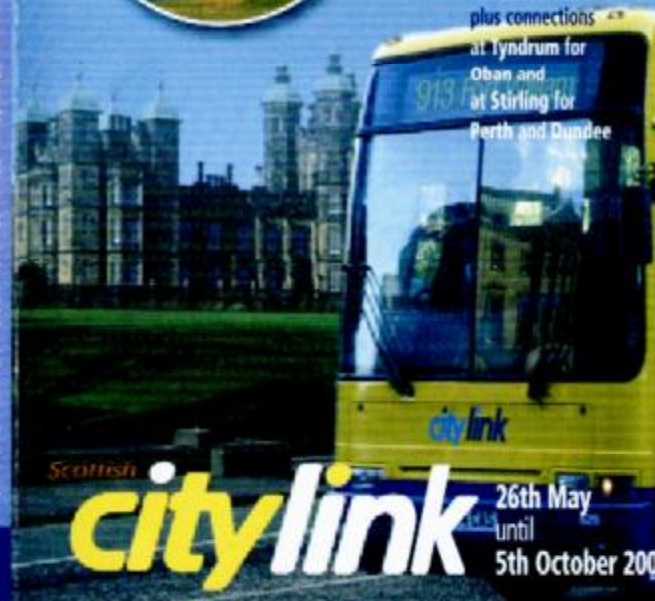
